| Ingham County Justice Millage Question | Capital Area District Library Ballot Proposal for a District Wide Tax |
| <p>For the purpose of constructing, equipping, and financing a new combined justice complex facility and expanding correctional programming, to include a new county jail, Sheriff's department offices, and court facilities, which would replace the existing facilities and will be safer for the public, staff and inmates, and allow for more efficient operations; and including programming for the treatment of substance addictions, treatment of mental illness, and reduction of re-incarceration among arrested persons, shall the Constitutional limitation upon the total amount of taxes which may be assessed in one (1) year upon all property within the County of Ingham, Michigan be increased by up to 85/100 (0.8500) of one (1) mill, \$0.85 per thousand dollars of state taxable valuation, for a period of twenty (20) years (2018-2037) inclusive? If approved and levied in full, this millage will raise an estimated \$6,207,147 in the first calendar year of the levy, based on state taxable valuation.</p> <p>Yes <input type="radio"/></p> <p>No <input type="radio"/></p> | <p>Shall the Capital Area District Library renew its annual tax levy upon the taxable value of all property, subject to ad valorem taxation, within the District of the Capital Area District Library in a renewal amount not to exceed 1.56 mills (\$1.56 per \$1000 of taxable value) for a period of 4 years 2018 through 2021 inclusive, to continue funding library operations?</p> <p>The renewal amount of 1.56 mills is \$1.56 per thousand dollars of taxable value. If approved and levied in full, this millage renewal request of 1.56 mills will generate an estimated \$10,308,630 for the Capital Area District Library during the first calendar year. If approved and levied in full, a small portion of the millage will, pursuant to statute, be disbursed to the Downtown Development Authorities of the Townships of Delhi and Lansing; as well as the Brownfield Redevelopment Authorities of the County of Ingham, the City of Lansing, and the Township of Delhi; and the Ingham County Land Bank.</p> <p>Yes <input type="radio"/></p> |
