

ALAIEDON TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES MINUTES
Monday, October 22, 2018

The regular Alaiedon Township Board meeting held Monday, October 22, 2018 was called to order at 8:00 p.m. by Supervisor Steven Lott. Members present: Supervisor Steven Lott, Clerk David Leonard, Treasurer Scott Everett, Trustee Beth Smith, Trustee Kurt Kranz, and Deputy Clerk Virginia Coffman.

Deb Dansby and Josh Sanford were also in attendance.

Motion by Leonard, supported by Everett, to approve the minutes of the October 8, 2018 meeting as printed. Motion carried.

Motion by Everett, supported by Smith, to approve the agenda as printed. Motion carried.

Deb Dansby of Dog Gone Fun attended the meeting to seek direction from the Board about her proposed business to be located at 2869 Jolly Road, Okemos. This proposal would be dog boarding, dog daycare, grooming and training with a maximum of 105 dogs in a 14,000 sq ft building on a .96 acre parcel in an industrial zoning. She proposes to have 11 employees. She presented an interior and exterior site plan with provisions for noise control.

The Board believed a Special Use Permit would be required.

Ms. Dansby thanked the Board for their time.

Motion by Leonard, supported by Smith to approve the copy as provided by Ms. Eagey, a descendent of the Strickland family, for a 4 ft wide by 3 ft tall sign to be placed at the Strickland Cemetery located on Holt Road. Motion carried.

Motion by Leonard, supported by Smith, to approve the invoice of \$3,450.00 for the testing of wells in Alaiedon Township. Motion carried.

Motion by Kranz, supported by Everett, to pay the following invoices: General Fund check #14265 through #14275 and seven electronic transfers in the amount of \$13,627.65. Tax Account check #6523 through #6525 in the amount of \$2,663.01. Trust and Agency Account three electronic transfers in the amount of \$5,220.41. Motion carried.
