

ALAIEDON TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES MINUTES
Monday, September 25, 2017

The regular Alaiedon Township Board meeting held Monday, September 25, 2017 was called to order at 8:00 p.m. by Supervisor Steven Lott. Members present: Supervisor Steven Lott, Clerk David Leonard, Treasurer Scott Everett, Trustee Beth Smith, Trustee Kurt Kranz, and Deputy Clerk Virginia Coffman.

There was no public in attendance.

Motion by Leonard, supported by Smith, to approve the minutes of the September 11, 2017 meeting and the agenda as printed. Motion carried.

The Board received the September 18, 2017 Planning Commission Minutes.

Trustee Smith reported about the Planning Commission meeting which they received information about the regulation of Solar Farms for a possible amendment to the Zoning Ordinance. The Planning Commission would like more information and made a recommendation to the Township Board that there be a moratorium on solar farms for a minimum of 9 months.

Motion by Everett, supported by Smith, to place a moratorium on Commercial Solar Farms for 9 months. Commercial Solar Farm does not include the construction of Solar panels for personal consumption of less than 1 acre, requiring an accessory building permit. Motion carried.

Motion by Leonard, supported by Kranz, to approve Election Source to ready and test the new election equipment for the November 7, 2017 Special Election at the cost of \$1,260.00 for the five ballots in three precincts. Motion carried.

Motion by Kranz, supported by Smith, to pay the following invoices: General Fund check #13787 through #13798 and five electronic transfers in the amount of \$16,482.43. Tax Account check #6344 through #6356 in the amount of \$3,580,837.19. Trust and Agency Account three electronic transfers in the amount of \$5,534.55. Motion carried.

Motion by Leonard, supported by Kranz, to adjourn. Motion carried at 8:45 p.m.
