

RECYCLING DROP OFF

ALAIEDON TOWNSHIP

Now it's even easier to RECYCLE MORE. All materials can go in the container together. No sorting is required.

BE GREEN. BE CLEAN.

Drop-off recycling is provided at no cost to you and your neighbors. Please help us ensure the site can continue to operate by being GREEN and CLEAN.

BE GREEN. Recycling works best when you follow the guidelines on this page.

BE CLEAN. Keep the site neat for you and your neighbors. Do not dump trash. Break down all boxes. Make sure all recyclables are placed in the container provided, not on the ground. (If no container is present, do not leave recyclables.) Do not include plastic bags or bagged materials.

TIN CANS & ALUMINUM CANS/TRAYS

Rinse clean and flatten. **NO:** plastic bags, paint cans, appliances, hangers, fencing, scrap metal, aerosol cans or containers with food residue

MIXED RESIDENTIAL PAPER

Newspaper, magazines, catalogs, office paper and junk mail are accepted. **NO:** plastic or paper bags; string; twine; stickers, coins or plastic stuck on papers; books

MIXED PLASTIC BOTTLES & TUBS

Containers with #1 through #7 symbols on bottom accepted, including bottles and jugs with narrow, threaded neck, plastic tubs (margarine, sour cream, cottage cheese, etc.), microwave trays and yogurt containers. **NO:** plastic bags, paper wax-coated milk or juice cartons, Styrofoam containers/packaging, syringes, garden hose/rubber, furniture, pools, toys, or free flowing liquids

NOW ACCEPTING CARDBOARD AND BOXBOARD

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD, BOXBOARD & BROWN PAPER BAGS

Break down boxes and remove any contaminants (Styrofoam, wood or food). **NO:** plastic bags; wax-coated boxes; 6-, 12- or 24-pack beverage cases; boxes containing liquids or food residue; freezer or refrigerator food boxes; boxes with foil lamination

RECYCLE MORE at the Alajedon Township Recycling Drop-off

Now it's even easier to RECYCLE MORE! You no longer have to sort your recycling before bringing it to the recycling drop off. All materials can be collected and put in the container together.

This type of recycling is what is referred to as single-stream or comingled recycling. With single-stream recycling, all materials are collected and baled together before being shipped to a single-stream facility where it is sorted using specialized equipment.

The recycling drop-off, which is located at Alajedon Township Hall at 2021 Holt Road in Mason, is open to all township residents. Recycling is available the third Saturday of the month from 8 a.m. to noon.

Accepted items include tin cans and aluminum cans/trays, mixed residential paper, mixed plastic bottles and tubs (#1 through #7), corrugated cardboard, boxboard and brown paper bags.
